2018 August CONNECTION HIE Highland Baptist

Wow that was quick! Summer break is already over! Let me share with you our semi-annual update on where we are in relation to our Vision 2022 goals. Our mission is to glorify God through the inward edification and the outward multiplication of followers of Christ! Our vision is to CONNECT WITH GOD & OTHERS, TO GROW IN QUALITY & QUANTITY, TO SERVE IN THE CHURCH AND TO GO SHARE JESUS as we continually seek to reach the goals of seeing 17 annually saved, baptized and set on the road to discipleship, to see 300 in Sunday morning worship, to see \$400,000 in annual giving, to see 100 individuals discovering and using their spiritual gifts to serve in the church, and 100 individuals trained and sharing the gospel locally and around the world by the year 2022.

As I have said before, this is going to be a marathon over the next 5 years, not a sprint. God has already blessed us tremendously and we have gotten a good start to reaching those goals in these first 6 months of 2018. In 2016 we saw 2 baptisms for the entire year, but as of the end of June 30th we have seen 1 baptism for the year with 1 more coming this Sunday and our goal this year is 5 baptisms! At the end of June, we've seen our attendance grow from an average of 150 in 2016 to an average of **199** and our goal for 2018 is **200**! Then in the area of our giving we've grown from \$319,876 in budget offerings for 2016 to \$187,941.73 at the end of June and if we continue this pace of giving we'll be at \$375,000 by the end of the year, which is almost 2 years ahead of where we should be at this time in reaching our 2022 goal of \$400,000! We didn't have any results from the previous years to measure these last two goals of Serving and Going with, so we decided to start both of these at **0**. I'm very happy to report to you that as of June 30th we've had **16** who've shared with us that they've discovered their spiritual gifts (more need to let us know what you discovered) and 38 have had some kind of evangelistic training and our goal for each of these for this year was 20!

Also don't forget to give over and above your regular offerings to help our church begin supporting a church planter in Calgary, Alberta, Canada. Our goal is **\$5000** over the next two months and so far we have received **\$2860**! By the way, that kid (church) I talked about last month that came back from summer vacation sure doesn't look like she did 1 ½ years ago! Let me encourage you to keep your focus on the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus! God is continuing to bless us as we seek to follow His vision for the direction of our church to CONNECT, GROW, SERVE and GO! To God be the glory, great things He hath done!



The Calgary Challenge

God is at work in Calgary! Since 2016, God has been raising up church planters and sending them to Calgary in unprecedented numbers. By the end of 2018, leaders are projecting there to be more than 50 Southern Baptist churches underway in Greater Calgary.

A Challenge for the DRBA: The church planters answering God's call to go to Calgary must raise much of their own support. The cost of living in Calgary is significantly higher than the U.S. south. Just the cost of moving, securing housing, and getting on one's feet can easily be \$5,000.

The DRBA is issuing a call to our churches to join together to help send as many new church planters to Calgary as we can. Our initial goal is \$35,000 to send seven church planting families to Calgary (\$5,000 each for moving, housing, and getting established.)
