Love is something our world is almost obsessed with. We sing about it, we write about it, we read about it and we watch movies and tv shows about it. Psychiatrists say that three of the greatest needs of a human being are: The need to be wanted, the need to be needed and the need to be loved.

This month there's a whole industry built around a holiday, Valentine's Day, that celebrates what we think is love, but true love is so much more! The Bible tells us that God's nature is love, because "God is love." Someone said, "Love doesn't define God, but God defines love." Love is what the entire mission of the church is built around, the two great commandments: **Love God and Love Others!** When we're fulfilling the mission of loving God and loving others, it will also strengthen our church, our families and our relationships with others. Paul says, "For God demonstrated his love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8) The cross isn't just the demonstration of love; the cross is the definition of love.

**True love is sacrificial love.** God gave his only begotten Son. When God gave his very best, He spared nothing in bringing us salvation. The cost of true love is sacrifice. **True love is also selfless love.** God sent Jesus not for what it would do for Him, but for what it would do for us. Real love is a love that seeks to meet the need of someone else. Jesus also tells us "*A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.*" (John 13:34) Loving one another wasn't a new commandment, but it was a new commandment to love as Jesus loved us. **True love can also be seen**. Love isn't a noun that you feel; it's a verb that you do. Love isn't a matter of can or can't; it's a matter of will or won't. The kind of love that

Jesus had wasn't so much in words as it was in deeds. He never just said, "I love you," but He showed it by healing the sick. by feeding the hungry, by ministering to the hurting and by dying for the world. Jesus said, "By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." (John 13:35)

Love is the thermometer that can take your spiritual temperature. If you were put on trial for being a Christian, love would be the one incontrovertible evidence to convict you of being saved. How is the world going to know that Jesus really makes a difference? How is the unbeliever going to know that this thing called "Christianity" is real? It won't be by how much we say that we "love God" or even how much we say we love Jesus, because that's just talk. Jesus said the way you can become a magnet that will draw people to you, the way you will make people sit up and pay attention and say, "Maybe there's something to this Christian business, maybe Jesus really does make a difference and I should follow him" is when we love one another.

The world isn't going to know that we are followers of Jesus because of a bumper sticker on our car, or a lapel pin on our coat, or a cross around our neck. They're going to know it and believe it when they see us loving each other in a way they aren't loved by the outside world. Let us love sacrificially and selflessly so that the world may see that God loves them. May this be a month dedicated to Loving God and Loving Others!
