Summer begins for most families with Memorial Day Weekend and it will end at the beginning of August when school returns, or for some at Labor Day in September. In churches, this season is notoriously referred to as "The Summer Slump!" which means that attendance, participation, and giving at church usually drops off as people go on vacations and there are more outdoor activities locally that compete for our attention. Kids are out of school and families want to maximize their time together unencumbered by the overscheduling of the rest of the year. And according to Lifeway, when compared to highest attendance months, average Sunday morning attendance drops by 23 percent in June and 34 percent in July. To overcome these statistics, churches have to be willing to get a little creative. What can we do to reverse the trend in our church? We can pray about it and hope for the best, or we can pray about it and develop a plan to overcome it. Summer doesn't have to be a low attendance time, even with all the vacations, sporting events, practices, and other summer activities. **One thing I want to challenge you to do over this summer is to refresh and recommit yourself to the vision of our church: CONNECTING with God and others, GROWING in quality and quantity, SERVING in the Church, and GOING to tell others about Jesus!**

First, make sure in these summer months to **CONNECT** with God and don't neglect your personal walk with Him while you're walking or lounging around that favorite vacation spot. Make sure to spend time each day this summer being spiritually refreshed as you're being physically refreshed. Also, seek to build new relationships with the people around you in the hopes of connecting them to Christ. Meet your neighbors, take friends with you to enjoy those summer activities or invite a coworker and their family for a summer outing. Secondly, make sure to continue to **GROW** in quality by using some of the down time that you'll be enjoying to read through a book of the Bible. Immerse yourself in a good biblical devotional or get together with some friends at home for a summer Bible study. You can also invite your friends to some of our summer activities like VBS, kayaking trips, Father's Day Service, 5th Sunday Dinner and Sing, and numerous other youth activities as we seek to GROW in quantity. Third, you may want to look at new ways to **SERVE** in the church this summer like serving in Vacation Bible School, helping out with youth activities, singing in the choir or at the 5th Sunday sing, visiting those in the nursing homes, setting up and taking down the Project Patriot flags for the 4th of July, helping with security, or serving in the kitchen. Finally, recommit yourself to **GO** share the gospel with at least one person this summer. You may not feel comfortable sharing with others yet so we will be providing some evangelism training soon to help you overcome those fears and to help you find the way that works best for you to share with others what Jesus has done for you. In the meantime, let me encourage you to invite people to come to some of the events we'll be having this summer where they can hear, and you can even share, the gospel. Invite others to VBS, the Hotdog and Swim Outreach events at our church, participate in the Jesus Tent at Bonnaroo, and look for other ways to share with your neighbors and those who are lost in Tullahoma.

Summer doesn't have to be a slump! Summer can be the most **SPECTACULAR** time of the year for us as a church if we'll keep our focus on the Lord and recommit ourselves to the vision He has placed before us!

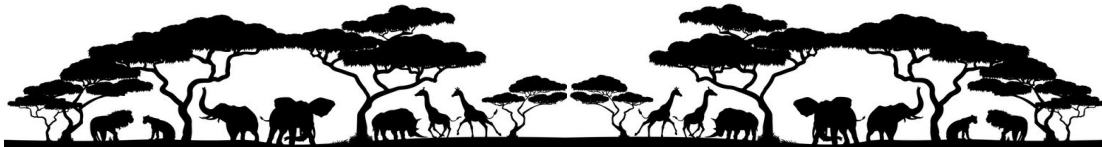


Highland on Mission
