When missionaries Jeremiah and Joy Farmer were forced to leave the East Asian country where they served, Jeremiah began to think about creative ways to work with local partners from a distance. One way was setting up trainings and meetings to equip and mobilize believers to make disciples. One such meeting happened on a boat dock where Jeremiah witnessed deep partnerships forge among believers. They were open and honest in a way he had not seen before. Not only were the East Asian leaders working through their differences, but they were also able to make concrete ministry plans together.
