Last month I shared how we're called to be salt and light in the world, which demands that we live a life of holiness, to live a life that is different. I shared how we're to be set apart for God's purpose to make the greatest eternal difference in His kingdom's work.

As followers of Christ, we are to be holy or different for God, which means that we're to think differently, live differently, love differently, and talk differently. Right living is to be a natural outgrowth of our right thinking. When we begin to think new thoughts, we begin to live a distinct life. Any man or woman who accomplishes anything worthwhile must have the courage to live differently than the world because they're marching to the drumbeat of a different drummer. As we think holy and live differently for God, that should cause us to love differently. 1 Peter 1:22 says, "22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart." Love sets us apart, and it's to be the display of holiness. Love is also to be the litmus test for Christians. It's not just any kind of love. It's a sincere, genuine, authentic love. We're to love like God loves us, meaning our motive isn't to get but to give. Our love is to be a deep love that is intense, fervent, and loves with all of our strength. Christian love, though, is not just a feeling; it's a matter of the will, and it's to be a pure love that is spotless and clean. All too often, we talk romantically about loving from the heart. God speaks realistically about loving from a pure heart. This is the same kind of love Jesus talked about in John 13:35 when he said, "By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." When we love one another—sincerely, deeply, and purely—people will know that you're different, and they'll know that you're a follower of Christ. Oh, that the world would look at the church today and say, "Behold, how they love one another."

you live, the way you love, and the way you talk. The words we use reveal most whether we're truly different or not. We live in a world that uses words to put people down and tear people up. Those who are different and living holy lives will use their words to build people up. So, what are your words revealing about your heart? Words are powerful and have the power to edify and give life, but they also have the power to discourage and kill dreams. Have you ever had your joy stolen because of someone's reckless words or had your self-esteem destroyed by someone's hurtful words? Today, the world has a desperate need for people who are different. We need people who'll carry their faith into the office, into Congress, into society, into the school, and into the home. We need people who'll be different even if it costs them their social popularity, their economic fortunes, or their very lives. You only get that kind of distinctiveness through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. He's the one that sounds the drumbeat of the different drummer. He's the one who calls us to stand out of the crowd, to be distinct, separate, and unusual. He calls us to be different. Be different, be holy that others might see something different in you that would cause them to want to know Jesus as their Savior and Lord!
