Missionary Moment



In 2022, Life Community Church sent the Maddens to Weymouth, Massachusetts, to start a church just sixteen miles south of Boston.

Noah says Greater Boston faces a significant amount of hopelessness and drug addiction. God is using the Maddens to bring hope and healing to the community.

When the couple first came to Weymouth, they met Eric, who had struggled with addictions. God not only saved Eric, but also transformed him into a leader in the new church. Today, Eric is leading the church's recovery ministry and helping others give their lives to Jesus and overcome addictions.

The Cooperative Program takes the Gospel to the nations and the neighborhoods.
