# HE CONNECTION

May



This month's foundation of the church is spiritual maturity. Many Christians stay too close to where they began their faith journey. Contrary to common assumptions, regular church attendance, participation in Bible studies, or holding leadership roles in church don't guarantee spiritual maturity. Some of the most immature Christians have never missed a Sunday morning church service. In fact, the second greatest problem in the church issue is spiritually immature individuals in leadership positions. The sad truth is there are millions of Christians who grow older, but they never grow up. God's goal is for you to mature and to become more like Jesus every day. When a Christian stops growing they start backsliding; you never stay the same. If you're the same Christian today that you were a year ago, you're not the Christian that you ought to be. So how you can attain spiritual maturity.

First you have to desire spiritual maturity. In 1 John 2:12-13 John identifies three levels of spiritual maturity. In verse 12 he speaks of "little children." In verse 13 he speaks of "fathers" and also of "young men." We can see the same thing when we look at the church. Physically we can identify the children, we can identify the young people, and we can identify the fathers, or the mature adults. But interestingly, you can't equate physical maturity with spiritual maturity. In other words, you can't determine the spiritual maturity of an individual by their physical maturity. You may be looking at a young person who, in their spiritual maturity, is an adult, and you may be looking at an adult who, in their spiritual maturity, is a child. We ought to be moving through each of those stages throughout our spiritual life. We ought to be moving from feeding on the milk of God's Word to feeding on the meat of God's Word, with the ultimate goal of becoming a spiritually mature adult. The ultimate mark of maturity is when you know God. Not just the will of God, or the work of God, or the ways of God, or even the Word of God; but when you know God. Because the more you know the Father, the more you are going to become like the Father. If you're going to attain spiritual maturity, you've got to want to grow. You've got to decide to grow, make an effort to grow, and you've got to continue to grow.

The second step is to develop spiritual maturity. If you're going to grow as a Christian you have to live with, in, and by the Word of God. Unless you get into the Word of God yourself on a consistent basis, you'll never ever grow to full spiritual maturity. It's just this simple. Those who want to grow read their Bible; those who don't won't. If spiritual maturity is going to be a priority in your life, Bible study has to become a priority in your life. If you don't take time every day to spend time in the Word of God, so that you can hear the voice of the God of the Word, then you'll stay a spiritual baby all of your life. Don't think that you can come to church once a week and get spoon fed 30 minutes worth of truth and that's all you need. Just like you eat food for your physical body every day, you have to eat the meat of the Word of God for your soul every day.

The last step John tells us to spiritual maturity is that we have to demonstrate spiritual maturity. Spiritual maturity is demonstrated more by how you behave than it is by what you believe. If you believe what you say you believe, then it'll change the way you behave. We sometimes get the idea that if a person knows a lot about the Bible they must be spiritually mature. There are some who have a lot of head knowledge of the Bible, but they're not spiritually mature. Spiritual maturity isn't how much you know about Jesus in your head; it's how well you know Jesus in your heart, and how much you show Jesus in your life. That's why the real mark of maturity is obedience. James 1:22 says, "22 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." Every time something happens to us, good, bad, or ugly, it gives us an opportunity to respond in the way God would have us to, according to His Word, and when we do that then God builds character within us. God wants us to grow bigger every day on the inside than we are on the outside. You can believe something but if it doesn't change how you live then it's meaningless.

Grow in Spiritual Maturity!
