Every December, the world slows down for a few days to celebrate Christmas. Christmas is my favorite holiday of the year. I love the decorations, the Christmas lights, the sounds of Christmas music, the cooler weather (even the snow), the nativity displays and especially the gathering of families to celebrate the season together, whether in person or through Facetime. For many people, Christmas has become more about the season than the Savior. They enjoy the music, the memories, and the magic of it all, but they've lost sight of the reason we celebrate in the first place is the birth of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. It's incredible when you think about it. Jesus never wrote a book. He never led an army. He never traveled more than a few hundred miles from His home. And yet, two thousand years later, His birth divides all of history into before and after. His name still captures the attention, devotion, and even opposition of the world. Christmas is not simply about a baby in a manger, it's about God Himself stepping into human history.

The apostle Paul gives us one of the clearest pictures of what Christmas really means in Philippians 2, "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men." In other words, before Jesus was born in Bethlehem, He was, and still is, fully God. That word "form" refers to the very essence or nature of something. Just like the seal of a Roman emperor carried the exact image of his authority, Jesus carries the exact image of God. When you look at Jesus, you are looking at God in human flesh.

But here's the miracle: Jesus didn't cling to His equality with God. He didn't hold onto His heavenly privileges. Instead, He "emptied Himself, by taking the form of a servant." When Jesus came into this world, He didn't stop being God, He simply added humanity to His deity. He was fully God and fully man. That's what makes Christmas the greatest miracle the world has ever known, that God became one of us. Think about that. The Creator of the universe borrowed a stable for His birth, He borrowed a boat to preach from, He borrowed a donkey to ride on, and He even borrowed a tomb for His burial. The Son of God chose to live like a servant so that He could bring us into the family of God.

That's the heart of Christmas. The heart of Christmas is about giving, God giving us His only begotten Son. If you've ever wondered why God would do that? Why would He leave the glory of heaven to come to earth as a helpless baby? Well Paul gives us the answer through Jesus' own words in Acts 20:35: "It is more blessed to give than to receive." That's the very heartbeat of God. Giving is who He is. Love gives and at Christmas, God gave His very best. We live in a world that says, "You'll be happier if you get more." But Jesus says, "You'll be most blessed when you give more."

When we give of our time, our resources, our love then we're walking in the footsteps of the One who gave everything for us. Giving doesn't take from you what you should have kept. It gives to you what you never could have received any other way: joy, peace, and a sense of purpose that fills your heart. At this time of year especially don't forget to give. Give to make the greatest impact you can for the kingdom of God and for His glory! That's what Christmas teaches us. The greatest gift you'll ever give is yourself: first to God, then to others.

Christmas is more than a story to be told. It's an invitation to be accepted. God is inviting you to experience His greatest blessing which is a personal relationship with His Son, Jesus Christ. Maybe this Christmas finds you weary, worried, or lonely. Remember this: the same God who humbled Himself to be born in a manger is the same God who wants to dwell in your heart. He came not only to save you, but to walk with you every day of your life. So I want to encourage you to pause in the midst of the season's busyness and simply thank God for the gift of His Son. Fix your focus on Jesus. Put your faith in Him. Give your fears to Him. And trust your future to Him. That's why I love in Christmas!
